Notebook (Computers/Tablets)

- Keep it in the case at all times.
- Don't throw your backpack with your computer in it!
- Power cords cost \$20.00 if lost or broken. Leave them at home.
- Don't lend your laptop to anyone.... if they break it, YOU are responsible for paying for it.
- Make sure you shut down correctly to receive all updates (go to start, power, shut down.)
- Don't change the desktop, backgrounds, etc.
- Bring them to school every day, to every class
- Remember that your every move is being tracked!
- Do not use any products to clean your computer; if need be, use vinegar and water.
- It's your responsibility to charge your notebook every night and/or during Language Arts class.
- Do not try to download ANY programs, games, music, etc....it is not your personal computer.
- No playing on computers at lunch or recess.
- If you have a problem, bring it to Mrs. Rutter (D108). Do not let anyone else try to fix it!
- You will abide by the rules, or your computer could be taken away.

Internet use at home:

- 1. Click the internet access signal button at the bottom right corner of your desktop.
- 2. Click on your home wifi network.
- 3. Enter your home wifi network password (ask your parent or guardian for help).
- 4. Go to the desktop and double-click on the "At Home Login" icon.
- 5. Enter the same username and password that you do when you log onto/turn on your notebook computer:
